Dear Members,

Sadly, I would remind you that for the foreseeable future, the Club will remain closed. A small skeleton staff will continue to work in the clubhouse on club business but no admission will be given to club members.

The Board will review the situation on an ongoing basis and the Club will reopen as and when the Government permits. Notwithstanding the closure, can I emphasise the points made to you by John Turner in our recent email communication about COVID-19. It remains important that members continue to pay their 2020/21 subscriptions where their personal circumstances allow as it is not possible even in this period of closure to reduce the Club's costs to zero. Please note, payment by bank transfer is the preferred method of payment as the office is not open for as long as it would normally be.

A member paying their subscription (or entering into a direct debit arrangement) by 31 March will have the membership extended by a period equal in length to the period during which the clubhouse is closed.

A member who is unable to renew, or chooses not to do so, by that date but who re-joins later in the year will not be charged a joining fee but will of course not benefit from the extended membership offer. A member who fails to renew will of course cease to have access to the Club from 1 April 2020.
